Outdoor Services	Chainsaw	Cuts Eye injury Crush Hearing loss	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use restricted to experienced operators only. • Protective clothing/equipment to be used (hard hat, goggles, gloves, earmuffs, chaps and sturdy footwear). • Ensure 10 m safety zone is maintained between operator and work crew members. • Ensure appropriate tree fall zone is maintained (as specified by Supervisor).
Outdoor Services	Scrub cutter/hedge trimmer	Cuts Eye injury Crush Hearing loss	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use restricted to experienced operators only. • Protective clothing/equipment to be used (safety glasses, gloves, chaps, earmuffs, sturdy footwear). • Ensure 10 m safety zone is maintained between operator and work crew members.
Outdoor Services	Skill saw, drills, power tools	Injury Electrocution	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use restricted to experienced operators only. • Protective clothing/equipment to be used (safety glasses and gloves). • Ensure safe distance to other workers is maintained. • Electrical compliance certificate.
Outdoor Services	Fuel storage	Explosion Burns Inhalation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fuel to be stored only in industry approved containers. • Fuel containers to be clearly labelled. • Do not use naked flames, grinders, saws or anything that makes a spark around fuel containers.
Outdoor Services	Chemicals (eg weed spray, paints, thinners solvents)	Skin irritations Respiratory Eye	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To be stored in appropriate containers. • Containers to be clearly labelled. • First aid instructions and equipment to be readily accessible. • Appropriate protective equipment to be used (overalls, gloves and masks). • Supervisor to oversee mixing of chemicals and application process.
Outdoor Services	Ladder use	Working at heights Falls	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ladders to be in good working order and non-defective. • Ladders to be used in accordance with manufacturer's specifications. • Ensure the ladder is resting on a solid footing. • Secure the top and/or base of the ladder if required. • Ensure extension ladders have at least a one in four base to height ratio.
Outdoor Services	Mower use	Cuts Amputation Hearing loss	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure mower engine is turned off to refuel. • Ensure mower engine is turned off to clear any obstructions. • Ensure 3 m distance between mower operators. • Ensure protective clothing is worn (sturdy footwear, earmuffs). • Traffic cones are to be used and vests worn when working roadside. • Keep fingers and toes clear of blades.

Outdoor Services	Lifting heavy objects	Sprains Strains	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure “best practice” lifting methods are used at all times. • Workers to bend their knees rather than their back when lifting. • Know your limits ask for assistance. • Ensure lifting equipment is used to lift heavy loads.
Outdoor Services	Stock, animals, insects	Bites and stings Attacks Injured animals	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hazard inspection before work commencing. • Avoid working when stock in the same location. • Carry first aid and sting treatments.
Outdoor Services	Uneven Ground	Falls Sprains	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Exercise care when walking/ working on uneven surfaces. • Ensure footwear is appropriate and soles are not excessively worn.
