Plan Change 1 Dark Skies - Stewart Island / Rakiura

Describe Proposed Plan Change

Proposed Plan Change 1 seeks to introduce additional lighting provisions to the Southland District Plan 2018 which relate to Stewart Island / Rakiura only. For clarification proposed Plan Change 1 does not apply to any surrounding offshore Islands for example the Titi / Muttonbird Islands, Ruapuke Island and Whenuahou / Codfish Island.

The purpose of proposed Plan Change 1 is to maintain, protect and enhance the night sky environment on Stewart Island / Rakiura and in particular the dark quality of the night sky.

Summary of Submissions

The Summary of Submissions document summarises the decisions and changes requested from each of the submissions received on the proposed Plan Change 1 Dark Skies. The further submissions process provides an opportunity for people to comment on those matters raised in the previous submissions.

Can I make a further submission?

Any person, who has an interest greater than the general public or is representing a relevant aspect of the public interest, can make a further submission, even if you didn't make a submission previously. However, further submissions can only support or oppose, part or all of an original submission. New issues cannot be raised.

After the further submissions have been received, a hearing will be held if submitters ask to speak to their submission. Council will then consider all submissions and release its decision. Submitters have the right to appeal the decision to the Environment Court.

Further submissions close on:

The process for public participation in the consideration of the proposal under the Resource Management Act 1991 is as follows:

- After the closing date for submissions, Southland District Council must prepare a summary of the submissions and this summary must be publicly notified; and
- There must be an opportunity to make a further submission in support of, or in opposition to, the submissions already made; and
- If a person making a submission asks to be heard in support of his or her submission, a hearing must be held; and
- Southland District Council must give its decision on the proposal (including its reasons for accepting or rejecting submissions); and
